
A 'Bra Bank' will be available on the night for you to deposit clean bras ALSO a raffle to raise additional funds.

We're surrounded by changes, aren't we? At this time of year, we're particularly aware of the changes that autumn brings. For many, this season makes them feel down, as they see the leaves falling and they think of the colder and shorter days ahead. However we respond to the changes that inevitably happen every year, it is good to remind ourselves that some things always stay the same; here are some verses from the Bible to encourage us:
