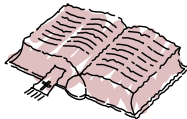

Dear Friends

On Sunday, 17th November, we will welcome the Bishop of Liverpool, the Rt. Rev'd. Dr John Perumbalath to our 10am Morning Communion service. Bishop John is still relatively new to the Diocese and we are pleased that he felt able to respond to our invitation back in February 2024. Arrangements are now well in hand. He will preside and preach. During the service he will also give a special devotional card signed personally by him to each person present as a memento of the occasion and an encouragement to our shared journey of faith in uncertain times. I do want to emphasise the importance of this service. A visit from the Diocesan Bishop is a fairly rare experience at All Saints and we want to make the best of this one.

First, to let Bishop John see that as many congregations across the Diocese, including our own Deanery, are declining, there is life, hope, and numerical growth here.

Secondly, to celebrate the signs of renewal at All Saints, not just the appearance of new faces but also the positive responses we have seen to our special services and events, most recently our successful Summer Fair and Sunday evening services. Both represent the fruit of prayerful thought, careful planning, responsive pastoral care, and the routine work of good publicity and leafleting homes with personal invitations.

Thirdly, to rededicate ourselves to the continuing work of mission in the parish. There is much to be thankful for here and still much to do.

Please make Sunday 17th November at 10am a very high priority in your diary and think of bringing someone with you. A memorable service will crown an encouraging year and set us up for a good Advent and Christmas season.
